On April 12, 2014, Police Officers responded to a residence in Pleasant Grove on a report of a baby found in a garage wrapped in a plastic bag. After arriving at the residence, Officers discovered a deceased infant inside a plastic bag. According to Darren West, the complainant, he contacted his estranged wife, Megan Huntsman, and inquired about the dead baby. According to Mr. West, Ms. Huntsman admitted the baby was hers, and told Mr West that she had placed the baby in the box after it was stillborn in 2006. The baby was well preserved and appeared to be full term. A search warrant was obtained for the home, and during the execution of the warrant, officers discovered six additional bodies. The bodies all appeared to be infants. Each baby was found wrapped in either a towel or a shirt, placed inside of a plastic bag, and each was contained in a separate cardboard box. That same day, officers contacted Megan Huntsman at her West Valley residence and asked that she accompany them back to Pleasant Grove. Ms. Huntsman agreed and returned with police to the Pleasant Grove Police Department. After Ms. Huntsman was advised of her Miranda rights, she waived her rights and agreed to speak to police. During her interview, Ms. Huntsman admitted that between 1996 and 2006, she gave birth to at least seven babies at the Pleasant Grove residence, and that all of the babies, but one, were born alive, and that she either strangled or suffocated the babies immediately after they were born. According to Ms. Huntsman, she then concealed their bodies inside boxes and placed them inside the garage of the Pleasant Grove residence.
