Orange Avenue in reference to an active shooter. Upon my arrival I could hear shots being fired and observed multiple people running across the S. Orange Avenue. I then immediately responded to the location of off duty unit Officer A. Gruler (10561).

I parked my marked patrol vehicle on West Esther Street on the south side of the business. Upon doing so and exiting the vehicle, I could see multiple people running out of the south door screaming. I could also hear multiple gunshots coming from inside the building. I also observed concrete and sparks flying from bullets coming through the south door. I then took a position of cover and concealment behind a vehicle and covered the door because at the time it appeared the shooter may exit this door.

Shortly after taking hard cover, I heard gunshots moving within the business. It appeared the shooter was possible moving to the north end of the business. Officer Gruler and I then moved cover to cover, paralleling the movement of the shooter. Upon reaching the north end of the business, I observed an open door. I then took another position of hard cover and covered this door because it sounded as if the shooter was moving towards this doorway. While covering the open door, large numbers of law enforcement backup arrived.

Shortly after I was alerted on the channel that the shooter had possibly barricaded himself in the bathroom of the business. At this time I assisted with searching the rest of the area for possible other shooters, covering the business and helped with the extraction of victims and witnesses.

On 6/12/16, I, Sgt. Torung (10956) responded to 1912 S. Orange Avenue (Pulse Nightclub) reference an officer needing immediate assistance with an active shooter.

Upon arrival I did not hear any more shots fired and met up with two OPD officers (NOI) at the intersection of Kaley and Orange Ave. Soon after, officers inside advised victim's would be coming out of Pulse. At that time I directed officers to send the victims and wounded to the rear of Einstein Bagels located on the southeast corner of Kaley and Orange Ave. All victims that were evacuated were placed behind Einstein Bagels and separated between injured and non injured. I asked Ofc. Alison Clarke (14159) to request OFD and paramedics set up triage on Kaley Avenue just east of Orange Avenue.

Upon the arrival of paramedics and the triage area being set up, I asked Ofc. Amanda Dowson (19721) to gather up the non injured victims and with the assistance of other officers, move the non injured victims behind a second wall separating Einstein Bagels from a parking lot to the east.

Medical personnel tended to the injured |

During the treatment of the wounded, medical personnel pronounced two individuals deceased and they were separated from the wounded and placed closer to Einstein Bagels wall and guarded by an officer.

CSI's Baumgaertner (19264) and D. Thomas (4853) arrived and were made aware of the deceased.

Once the non injured were separated, Det. April Brunner (8023) arrived and began interviewing the non injured witnesses and statements were handed out.

After some time further intelligence was gathered and the non injured needed to be moved further away from the scene. I then directed the movement of the non injured from the parking lot they were in to the north side of Kaley and onto Hollenbeck.

Ofc. Dowson and Ofc. Denise Perez (11104) along with other officers maintained security with the non injured while I returned to Einstein

Bagels. Once at Einstein Bagels I gathered a few officers and we prepared to begin the removal of further victims once the scene was secured by SWAT.

After SWAT's encounter with the suspect, I along with the officers behind Einstein Bagels rushed over to the south side of the Dunkin Doughnuts with backboards and stretchers to assist with the evacuation of the remaining victims.

Once the victims were evacuated and the scene was secured I left the scene.

I helped moved the wounded from the scene to the parking lot of 1901 South Orange Avenue (Einstein's Bros Bagel). I then assisted the Orlando Fire Department triage the victims and secure them on backboards.

I then responded to ORMC and coordinated officers and deputies on scene with a Mr. Lang (NOI) in the hospital command center.

Sergeant Pina

(11767) responded to ORMC and I continued to assist with the allocation of officers and deputies. I was relieved by Sergeant Gelespie (13679).

A requisition to replace my bike shoes was obtained due to possible biohazard on 6/13/16. The old shoes were placed into a biohazard bag and placed into the biohazard bin behind OPH.

On 6/12/2016, I, Ofc A. Clarke (14159) responded to 1912 S Orange
Avenue (Pulse Nightclub) in emergency mode in reference to an active
shooter. As I approached the scene, I stopped my marked patrol
vehicle on the east side of S Orange Avenue adjacent the 7-11, 1823 S
Orange Avenue, which is just north of the club.

As I exited my patrol vehicle I could hear gun fire still coming from inside the club. I began to run southbound towards the front of the club at which time I saw a large group of victims fleeing from the front entrance of Pulse, eastbound across S Orange Avenue. I ran towards the crowd and began to direct them to cover behind Einsteins Brother Bagels, 1901 S Orange Avenue, which is on the southeast corner of S Orange Avenue and E Kaley Street.

Sgt D. Toruno (10956), Ofc A. Dowson (19721), and I, along with other assisting officers began directing the hysterical victims to remain behind the cover of the building while assessing any possible injuries within the group. I moved to the southern side of the building and observed officers carrying injured victims towards S Orange Avenue in an attempt to load them into police vehicles and transport to the Orlando Regional Medical Center (ORMC).

When we realized there were no more vehicles to use for transport, we began to assist the officers with carrying the seriously injured victims behind the building. As more officers carried critical victims across S Orange Avenue, we established a triage area behind the building along the northside of the parking lot adjacent E Kaley Avenue. Sgt Toruno directed me to request ambulances respond and transport from our triage area. I requested OFD respond to transport critical victims from the triage area. I was initially told OFD would not be responding to our triage.

As we continued to assess the victim's injuries I realized there were two deceased victims in the triage area which was in close proximity to the large group of uninjured victims. The group began to walk towards the triage area in an attempt to identify the injured.

I approached Sgt Toruno and suggested we move the group in order maintain control. We directed the uninjured victims behind a brick wall on the east side of the parking lot and away from the triage area. Ofc D. Perez (11104), Ofc Dowson, Ofc J. Neigel (20061) and Ofc

C. Parente (30171) provided security for the area and maintained control of the group.

I returned to the triage area as more injured victims were being brought to the area at which time Ofc McCreless (16287) advised the



At that time I began re-assessing the victims as OFD had responded to our triage to transport the critical and seriously injured. I assisted loading the less critical victims into the back of Ofc J. Hyland's unmarked pickup truck for immediate transport to ORMC.

Once all the less critical victims were transported, and OFD was loading the rest of the victims for transport, I assisted Sgt N. Pina (11767) and Sgt K. Beers (13415) with moving patrol vehicles which were blocking route access for ambulances staged on E Kaley Street west of the intersection.

I then returned to the triage area at which time I saw Det. A Brunner (8023) gathering information from the group of uninjured subjects.

I returned to the triage area at which time one of the OFD ladder trucks had been positioned adjacent the rear brick wall in the parking lot. We laid out rows of backboards and prepared the triage area for the next group of injured victims. CSI C. Baumgaertner (19264) and CSI D. Thomas (4853) arrived and helped to establish a protected area for the deceased victims utilizing protective screens.

Sgt Toruno directed the group of uninjured victims to quickly line up and we escorted them to a secondary location further east on Hollenbeck Drive, midblock, behind an OFD ladder truck.

We returned to the triage area and had directed officers with long guns to provide security as the rest of us were going to carry the next grouping of victims to the triage area for OFD to assess and transport. We staged behind Einsteins at which time information was relayed over the channel that barricaded subject had contacted the communications center and there was a possibility he had explosives inside the club.

Once the information was relayed to OFD personnel, they retrieved all their equipment and advised they were moving the triage area to the north parking lot of Subway, 1742 S Orange Avenue. OFD left the triage area and did not return.

CSI Baumgaertner remained in the triage area and advised she would stay with the deceased victims so all the sworn officers could focus on rescue and transport of the victims once SWAT entered Pulse.

Sgt Toruno and Sgt Beers were able to obtain mass casualty carts from OCSO Emergency Response unit. We set up the carts and a few backboards in our triage area and re-accessed our plan for rescue and transport. Ofc J. Hyland retrieved his pickup truck in order to help assist with transport of victims. Several other police trucks and trailers from various agencies were also prepped to be used for immediate transport to ORMC.

Once OPD SWAT announced they had breached the west wall of Pulse; myself, Sgt Toruno, Sgt Beers, Ofc Perez, and other officers rushed westbound across S Orange Avenue with the mass casulty carts and backboards towards the rear of Dunkin Donuts, 2000 S Orange Avenue. I assisted with loading critically injured victims on carts and into various police vehicles for transport. I also assisted with searching the subjects exiting through the breach in the wall and directing them to either transport to ORMC or a secured area south of the rear parking lot of Dunkin Donuts.

Once all the victims were evacuated from the building and the immediate scene was secured, I left the area and staged near the OPD command post until I was able to retrieve my patrol vehicle from the scene and end my shift.

As a result of my involvement with the incident, I completed a requisition to replace my shoes, uniform pants and shirt due to biohazard contamination.

believed they had a shooter barricaded in a bathroom with several
people, now believed to be hostages.

I repositioned myself to the eastside of the building where two entrances faced and attempted to make entry to Pulse to extract any live victims. As we attempted to make entry into the south east door several shots were again fired and an unconscience victim was brought to the door by an unknown civilian. We carried the victim from the entrance to the Einstein's Bagel back parking lot which would provide some cover for victims. The individual appeared to be in very serious condition. I loaded the individual into the back of Officer D Perez's (11104) OPD vehicle and he was transported to ORMC as there were no OFD or Ambulance personal on hand to assist. During the next several minutes several gunshot victims that were alive but could not walk were located and carried to the area behind Einstein's. Several victims were transported in various OPD vehicles to ORMC until OFD personal responded to the triage area.

Lt. Brennan asked me to direct two units to ORMC to assist with the flood of victims, witnesses and family members in the emergency room. I requested that Ofc T Cruz (18937) along with Ofc Railey (31617) and Ofc T Funke (13929) respond to the hospital which they did.

Headquarters advised that the suspect that was inside of the bathroom had called 911 and was on the phone making statements. As a Crisis Negotiations Team member, I responded to the OPD Comm Center in an attempt to speak with the subject. Upon my arrival I learned that the subject was on the phone with Sgt A. Brennan who is also a Negotiator. I assumed my role of CNT Team Leader during the remainder of the incident at the Comm Center until SWAT had contact with the suspect.

On June 12, 2016, I, Officer Rine 15633 responded to calls of shots fired (active shooter) at 1912 S. Orange Ave. (Pulse Nightclub). Upon arrival, at approximately 0210hrs. I, exited my patrol vehicle and grabbed my patrol rifle to assist in locating the suspect. At this point I heard a series of gunshots being exchanged between more then one shooter. As I approached the nightclub I could hear several more shots being fired. I was then confronted by approximately 50-60 of what appeared to be uninjured individuals exit the nightclub from the patio area. I directed them across the street to Einstein Brothers Bagels where other officers were waiting to assist them while providing them cover to safely exit. After the individuals were across the street, I took a position of hard cover outside by the front door (Esther St. entrance) waiting for the suspect to possibly exit.

Soon after, I was advised that officers inside needed more assistance removing the injured from inside the nightclub. I gave another officer my patrol rifle who did not have one and went inside to assist other units with removing victims from the club. By 0235hrs all of the surviving injured that were in the bar and dance floor area were removed.

SWAT soon arrived on scene and relieved units inside of the nightclub and the patrol units that were inside went across the street to a parking lot on Esther St. to await the rescue of the victims being held hostage and were holed up in the bathroom.

SWAT made entry and myself and other units assisted with getting approximately 15-20 non injured and severely injured people to safety by utilizing stretchers and carrying victims to an unmarked pickup truck which was used to transport to the triage area and to the hospital.



Club which is located at 1912 S. Orange Avenue. The unit yelled that
he needed more units. I turned my vehicle around and started heading
towards the direction of Pulse Night Club.

Upon arrival, there were many patrol cars parked on Orange Avenue, just south of the Pulse Night Club. I pulled in front of OFD Station 5 (off of Kaley Street and S. Orange Avenue). I immediately noticed Sgt. N. Pina (11767) who was standing in front of OFD Station 5. I asked her how I can help. Sgt. Pina stated that victims needed help being transported to the hospital. There was a black male victim (with multiple gun shot wounds) who was right next to me. Another OPD officer (NOI) helped me to get him into the back of my patrol vehicle. I immediately took the male victim to the emergency room bay area located at the Orlando Regional Medical Center (ORMC) off of Miller Street and S. Orange Avenue. ORMC security and staff (NOI) helped in removing the victim from my patrol vehicle and placed him on a qurney and rushed him inside the emergency room area. I got back into my patrol vehicle and drove back to where Sgt. Pina was located. I exited the vehicle and asked Sgt. Pina what more I can do to assist. She requested that I go back to ORMC to assist with the receiving of additional victims that were being transported there. I headed back to ORMC and assisted ORMC emergency room staff with multiple victims brought in by other OPD officers, OFD Rescue trucks and private ambulances.

I responded to the shooting at Pulse when Officer Gruler called it out on the radio. When I arrived at S Orange Ave and W Kaley St I could hear shooting coming from within Pulse. I entered Pulse from the patio. I heard quashots inside the club, but could not discern where they were coming from. I heard Lt Scott Smith (5581) tell units to begin triage. Someone yelled grab and go. An unknown man, lying on the floor, reached up for assistance. He told me he could not stand or walk. He had at least one visible gunshot wound to his right leg. I grabbed both of his wrists, and he grabbed mine. I dragged him outside of the club through the patio, and away from the building. I reentered Pulse through the patio. I located another unknown male lying on the floor. He too was unable to stand or walk. I grabbed him by both wrist and he grabbed mine. I pulled him from the building, through the patio, and across S Orange Ave to Einstein Bagel, where OFD was setting up a triage area. I informed the OFD commander that there were many victims and we were in need of many ambulances. I got a pair of latex gloves from someone and went back into Pulse. At this time someone opened an interior door on the north side of the business (adjacent to the bar). Officers and Deputies ordered the person out, but they retreated back and closed the door. We repositioned ourselves after learning that through that door is a ladder leading up to an office. An OPD officer opened the door and ordered the person out. We learned that there were still multiple people upstairs. The people in the office descended the ladder one at a time and exited the doorway, toward us. They were all directed out of the building. I exited through the entry door on the south side of the building.

I worked with OPD, UCF and GOAA K9 units to coordinate sweeps of all staging areas and the parking lot to the tint business to the north of Pulse. I ordered units to expand the evacuated area based on the information provided by the K9 handlers.

My significant exposure was documented under OPD case number 2016-242683.

We stopped the unmarked patrol vehicle just south of Kaley Street on South Orange Avenue. I made my way through the window tinting business parking lot just north of Pulse, with just my Pistol. Once I approached the front of the club, I noticed a sergeant (NOI) standing behind a car. I asked the Sergeant if we were going in. He advised me `I`m not your Sergeant.` After that Officer Imburgio, Officer Medvetz and I headed for the east entrance of Pulse, through the patio.

I made entry first with Officer Medvetz behind me and Officer Imburgio behind Officer Medvetz. Once I entered in to the club, I noticed about 60 victims lying on the floor. Officer Medvetz and I went left to the south side of the building. Officer Imburgio went right to the north side of the building. Officer Medvetz and I came to a closed door approximately 10 feet south of the east entrance. Officer Medvetz was holding security to the open floor where the 60 victims were laying. I tried to open the door but I felt something pulling back on it, holding it closed. I announced that I was the Orlando Police Department and the door open freely. Once the door opened victims started running out. The victims tried to run back in to the club. I was unaware where the shooter was at that point so I held my pistol in one hand pointing it at the crowd running out of the bathroom and with my other hand pushing the victims out the patio door. Once the last victims ran out I entered by myself, to what I later found out to be a bathroom, once I made entry, I cleared the bathroom and came up negative for the shooter.

I exited the bathroom and met back up with Officer Medvetz, we began to clear the rest of the south side of the building. I remember filling hands grab my ankles as I walked by the victims as they were asking for help. I jumped on the L shaped couch on the south wall to check the deep corner. Once the couch was cleared, we headed west along the south wall that led us in to the back bar area. There were a few closed doors and a deep hallway. As I made entry in to the back bar area, I saw two Orlando Police Officers, on the north side, Shooting down the deep hall way. At that time I could not see what

they were shooting at. Officer Medvetz and I held security on the south side of the bar. About 30 minutes passed when a dark skinned man came crawling out of the deep hallway, where the Officers were shooting. I ran to the subject and dragged him to the exit, where I passed him off to the officer outside. I came back to the south side of the bar where I waited for approximately 30 more minutes until I was replaced by SWAT Officers.



I walked back down to the club to assist with the injured. We staged on the south side of Pulse, behind Dunkin Donuts. Once SWAT made entry to the Westside of the building, myself and a few other Officers started to evacuate the victims. When the suspect started to shoot, I found cover behind a car and watched SWAT eliminate the threat. Once the shooting stopped, we were able to evacuate the last few victims.

Narrative Name: NARRATIVE SUPPLEMENT 6/29/2016 4:11 AM On 06/18/2016, at approximately 0200 hours, I Officer Falbo (16506) was working in an off duty status at the Eve nightclub located at 110 S Orange ave. I heard a call go out for the Pulse Nightclub regarding an `active shooter`. I responded to the scene and parked my vehicle just north of the club and proceeded on foot to the club.

I met up with several Officers who were surrounding the building and asked them where the shooting was coming from. I was unable to get a clear answer and proceeded to the front door of the club where I observed several Officers (NOI) `stacked` at the door. As I approached the Officers, I waived them into the building. Once inside of the building, I immediately noticed numerous bodies laying on the dance floor unresponsive as well as other people running franticly outside the front door. As I made it further into the building, I heard several gunshots from inside the club but I was unable to pinpoint where the shooter/shooting was coming from. The only thing I was able to tell after the shots being fired where that they were coming from the rear of the club directly in front of me. After the initial burst of gunfire, several other Officers (NOI) and myself made our way to the south/west side of the club to a hallway/exit door to which we took cover inside the building. At that point, it was discovered the suspect was possibly held up in a bathroom which was located directly in front of where I took cover. I covered the bathroom along with Sgt. Backhaus, Officer D. Cote, an Orange County Deputy (NOI) and unknown OPD Officer (NOI). While we were holding the bathroom several Officers began to enter the building rescuing victims from the club. After several minutes a male appeared from what appeared to be the mens bathroom yelling he was shot. The male was given orders to which he complied and was rescued by other Officers who dragged him from the club/red zone as cover was held on the bathroom to which we believed the suspect was in. During this time, we received a radio transmission that the suspect has pledged his allegiance to `ISIS`.

After these transmissions were made, we all remained on target and did not leave our positions inside of the club.

At this point, members of SWAT began to arrive and replace patrol. I and Officer Cote were eventually the last to be relieved and exited the club. Once outside, reports came in about shots fired at ORMC. I

After several hours, I was ordered by Lt. Donohue, to proceed to Florida Hospital South, to cover the main entrance of the hospital. On 6/12/2016, at approximately 0200 hours, I, Officer Austin (18921)
responded to Pulse nightclub at the intersection of Kaley Street and
South Orange Avenue in reference to a active shooter incident.

Upon arrival I parked on north west of the Pulse night club approximately 150 yards east of Orange Avenue on Kaley. I exited my marked Orlando Police Department vehicle (9060) and acquired by agency issued AR-15. I left my vehicle unsecured for other responding officers that were arriving behind me to use as cover. Moments later I shouted to another officer (NOI) to move my vehicle closer to use as cover for other responding officers. In the process I observed several Orange County Deputies and Orlando Police Department officers still arriving. At this time I made the decision to acquire 5-7 other officers and move towards the club from the north west corner.

During this time we moved in a line formation with one point man (Unknown Orange County deputy with a pistol) as I held a rifle. We moved swiftly and quickly along the north side of Pulse towards the front of Pulse as I observed several other officer moving into Pulse from the west side entrance, we proceeded past this entrance and around to the front south east corner of the building. I observed a vehicle in front of the double door entrance, the group of officers I was with took up positions covering two possible exits on the south side of the building. As I began to enter the Pulse Night club at the front door, I observed Officer Hyland (17447) lifting an unknown person who appeared to be fighting for their life towards the outside of the building. During this time, Officer Hyland was lifting them, walking backwards while trying his best not to drag their feet. I assisted by providing lethal support for Officer Hyland. Moments later, Officer Hyland fell to the ground. With one hand, and as best as I could, I held my rifle with my right arm and hand still pointing at the doorway and used my left hand to grab the right wrist of the victim. I pulled the victim behind the car on the south east corner of the Pulse night club while shouting to Officer Hyland `Move, get up, get behind the car!

I looked at Officer Hyland and shouted, `Where is your truck?` While other officers assisted in maintaining cover on the two exits we examined the victim behind the vehicle. Officer Hyland then ran to his unmarked truck parked on the east side of Fulse by Orange Avenue. As officer Hyland acquired his truck, I covered officers as they

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lifted deceased and badly wounded persons from within the club and from the south side of Pulse into the truck. It should be noted I observed at least four deceased outside the club on the south side along the south side perimeter of Pulse. There was a small fenced portion housing what appeared to be a shed and outside walk in freezer/cooler. Inside this fenced compound Officer Tabaczynski, a deputy and I found a deceased individual behind the door of the shed, between the door and the fence of the compound. Again I covered while officers pulled this individual out into the parking lot and again loaded him into the bed of the truck.

After this I acted as cover for officers on the interior perimeter by rotating with them periodically to maintain our energy and staying alert while not being fatigued. We would rotate while maintaining cover on doors inside the business. During that time I observed several injured parties rescued from interior rooms that were hiding from the gunman. At this time I can not remember how many ran out of the building from these rooms but I remember at least seeing three from the south side. While escorting one to the exterior units on the perimeter I was flagged down by family members of the victims inside the Pulse night club.

These family members stated that they had received multiple texts from their family members and friends stating that they were in the bathroom with the gunman. They began explaining how he spoke of Islam and pledging his allegiance to the Islamic State.

I immediately escorted these family members (four separate individuals) to a command post north of Orange Avenue and Kaley Street along with Officer Rush (30679). Once at the temporary staging area with Orlando Fire Department I met with Lieutenant Brennan (7597) and advised him of the intel that I was receiving. He ordered me to get these individuals to the command post which was located south of Harding Street and Orange Avenue. Officer Rush and I escorted them all there where they were still communicating with victims and trapped citizens inside.

Once at the command post, I was able to ascertain that one of the people worked at Pulse and knew the layout of the building. Also they knew their friend was located in the female bathroom. This same individual (NOI) was able to provide a diagram of the interior of the club and was able to pinpoint exactly where the female bathroom was in terms of door ways and large dance floor.

I drew the map of the interior of the club and provided this to Captain Canty (10046) and the staff inside the command post.

I then took up a position on the south side of Pulse Night club

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behind the Dunkin Donuts establishment (NOI). While en route however I observed a large crate of water, which I acquired and distributed to Officers and Deputies alike still waiting behind Dunkin Donuts (2000 South Orange Avenue) waiting to assist now SWAT Officers who had taken over the interior perimeter and whom were about to begin their assault on the Pulse building.

Soon after, SWAT personal breached the west side of the Pulse nightclub and victims began running out of the building. SWAT personal began pointing them south towards Harding Street. Officers met with these victims and began lifting them to safety. Officer Rush and I and met up again and went to assist. As we approached two SWAT personal approached us with an individual with at least four gun shot wounds to the legs hip and shoulder and bleeding badly. As I ran to assist these SWAT officers (NOI) I relieved them as they took up their previous positions, I began looking at the wounds the victim had and began speaking to him, `Stay with me, keep fighting!!! We will get you to safety, stay with us! Instantly afterwards, the suspect engaged SWAT personal and began shooting. I observed SWAT engage the suspect as I continued to do what I could to grab the victim, lift him along with two other officers and run south while numerous gun shots still were being exchanged. I observed an unmarked Edgewood or Winter Garden Police Department vehicle parked on W Muriel Street and South Orange Avenue. I shouted to the male Officer (NOI) I need help grab your truck. Without hesitation he dropped the back tail gate and we loaded the victim onto the back of the bed of the truck. Officer Imburgio (19018) directed him to the line of ambulances waiting on Kaley Street. I remained on my hands and knees looking into the victim's eyes while talking to him to 'Stay with me, I am here with you, your safe now! I would periodically tap on his left cheek to regain his attention and keep him alert as he would flex from the pain on the entirety of his body.

As we all pulled up to Kaley Street, we were directed by Ambulances and their personnel standing by that we needed to go to the Orlando Fire Department command post, located north of Kaley Street on South Orange Avenue. At this time several Engines and Towers were blocking our approach. I shouted at the medical staff, `Are you serious we can not get to them, you need to take him now!!` As multiple other victims arrived behind me other Ambulances began to follow suit and began picking up our victims on the back of the trucks arriving at this secondary location. I returned to the scene with the unknown municipality officer and immediately picked up three more victims.

During this time I picked up a black female with a gun shot to her right knee. She began screaming in agony as I knelt beside her and began holding her hand tightly while touching the right side of her face with my left hand. As I looked at her, I told her to stay strong and keep breathing. I told her that we were getting her an ambulance and taking her there to speed the process up. She nodded and began breathing heavily. During this time I realized I was covered in blood from my fingertips to my elbows. Although I was wearing gloves they

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had been torn and ripped to shreds and were falling from my wrists. After escorting these people to safety and watching them leave on ambulances I returned to the scene and attempted to assist further. At this time there was nothing further to assist with. I returned to my vehicle opened the door with a clean glove, acquired hand sanitizer and removed all blood from my hands and arms as best I could before being able to make it to a restroom later this morning.

Later this day, 6/12/2016, I returned to work approximately 1700 hours after leaving at 0900 hours this same morning. I was notified that units on scene required officers with fingerprint scanners. Officer Broder (18908) and I responded to assist. We were then notified that FDLE officers required our assistance at the Medical Examiners located on Michigan Avenue. Upon arrival Officer Broder and I began assisting the Medical Examiners Office and FDLE Officers with the identification and forwarding identified victims information to other FDLE Officers with awaiting families. During this time I coordinated with Lieutenant Brennan who was still on the scene of the original incident. At approximately 0400 hours, 6/13/2016, we had successfully identified 49/50 deceased individuals transported to the ME's office.
